





- 4) **Please describe the purpose and intent of the grant.**  
 We are currently completing construction to install lighted exit signs, doors with panic hardware, wired smoke detectors and alarms, enlarged bathrooms and other fire and disability access improvements. We are temporarily located at Saint Mark United Methodist Church during the construction. We expect to return to our youth center in mid-fall.
- We received a \$100,000 grant from Ahmanson Foundation for the improvements. The grant does not include funds for playground equipment to replace the basketball court we had to remove for a new parking lot with disabled access. We had to donate our plastic Duracourt surface to paint the parking lines. One of the hoops blocks the fire exit from our building to the alley. We need a smaller yet durable portable hoop that can be moved easily and used anywhere.
- 5) **How will this grant be used to primarily support or serve a public purpose and benefit the public at-large.**  
**(Grants cannot be used as rewards or prizes for individuals)**
- The grant will be used to purchase a Spalding 60" portable basketball hoop. It is easier to move than our current two hoops and will be used on our new back parking lot in an area away from our new fire exit. While most of our afterschool activities are for academic enrichment, free time from 5-6pm consists of playground games, particularly basketball. Also we have an annual summer basketball camp and an upcoming Hoops for Life tournament for teens. Both involve coaches and other mentors teaching our youth about teamwork, sportsmanship, persistence and more.
- Our free afterschool program is open to South LA-area youth in grades 3-12. With a 12-passenger van, we pick up students at several schools in the Gramercy Park and Athens Westmont areas, including LaSalle, Manhattan Place, Washington and Teach Academy. Other students are dropped off by parents who largely come seeking homework assistance and tutoring for their students, plus personal enrichment including sports and recreation.



Enclosed is a Neighborhood Purposes Grant application for \$1,267.86 for a new 60" Spalding basketball goal for our playground. We are currently upgrading our 3 buildings to meet fire code requirements. We had to replace our basketball court with a parking lot. We can use the lot for bball but the hoops we have are too large. They block the fire exit so we need at least one smaller, portable hoop.

The Wooten Center was founded in 1990 by Myrtle Faye Rumph in honor of her son, killed in a drive-by shooting. We provide free afterschool and low-cost summer programs for more than 300 students/year in grades 3-12 in the South Los Angeles area.

We are a college and career readiness program with activities including homework and tutoring, STEM and SAT-prep, college tours and scholarships, performing and visual arts, sports and recreation and more.

Our afterschool program is currently located at Saint Mark United Methodist at 83<sup>rd</sup> and Gramercy while our youth center undergoes improvements for fire and disability access. Ahmanson Foundation awarded a \$100,000 grant for the improvements. We expect to return in November with 3 buildings fully up to code, plus new paint, carpet, furniture and with your help a new basketball hoop.
